Auxiliary personnel seeking the UPV Examiner qualification may also seek out and train with an active duty Coast Guard inspector.

The qualification process is this:

- Meet the prerequisite qualifications contained in Sector Lake Michigan Instruction 16711, SECTOR LAKE MICHIGAN UNINSPECTED PASSENGER VESSEL EXAMINATION PROGRAM
- Complete the PQS training detailed in the Aux-UPV Examiner qualification booklet. This includes self study and actual UPV vessel exams under the supervision of a qualified examiner.
- Once the PQS is signed off, and the under instruction examinations are completed, the PQS cards get sent to the DSO-MS for review and verification.
- Once the PQS verification is completed, the DSO-MS will make arrangements for the UPV candidate to have an oral board made up of at least 1 qualified auxiliary UPV examiner and one active duty or reserve person designated by the Gold side.
- The board members will either recommend, via the prevention department head, that the Sector commander issue a letter of qualification to that member, or inform the member of areas needing further study and training.
- Once the Sector commander issues the letter, that individual auxiliary can do UPV examinations and train other members in that skill as well.
